- Bring this completed worksheet to Seminole Community College along with your SIGNED tax forms and any other documents requested as soon as possible, so that your financial aid processing can resume.

What our office will do:

- Financial Aid Specialists will compare the information on the documents and submit any corrections that need to be made electronically to the Federal Processor.
- Due to the volume of processing during peak times, aid disbursement may be delayed 4-6 weeks. Applications are completed based on document receipt dates.
