Split Plans - Retirees may enroll in one of the BlueMedicare plans while their spouses are enrolled in a non-BlueMedicare plan (Plans A, B, E, or F); similarly spouses may enroll in one of the BlueMedicarePlans while the retirees are enrolled in Plans A, B, or E. Example, the monthly premium for a retiree enrolled in Plan A with a spouse enrolled in BlueMedicare (*In-State*) would cost \$728.38 (\$474 + \$254.38). It would be the same cost if the spouse was enrolled in Plan A while the retiree was enrolled in BlueMedicare (*In-State*).

Note: Plan C and Plan D are not available to Retirees
